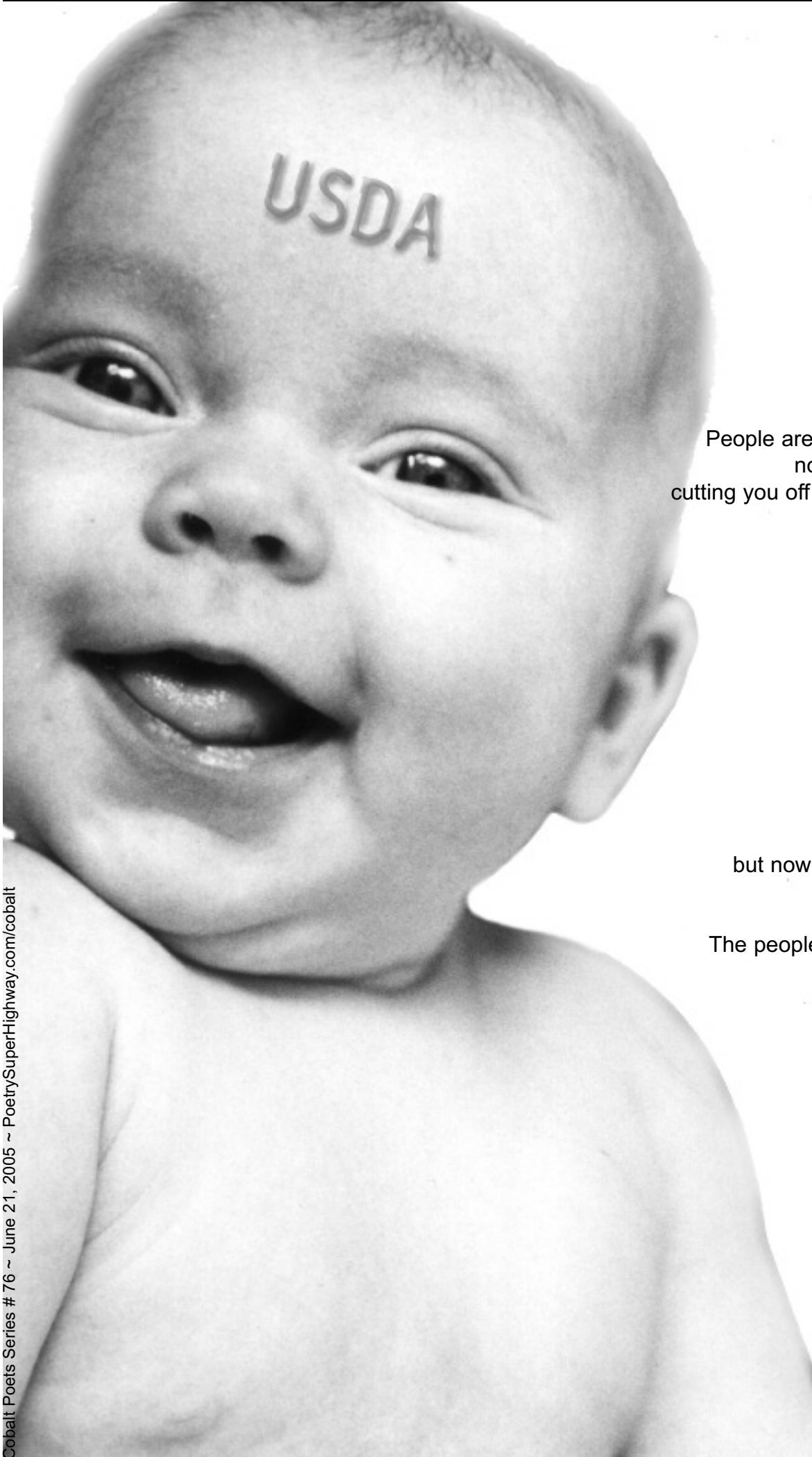


# Teka-Lark Lo
