A two-time Pushcart Prize Nominee, Rick Lupert has collaborated in live performance with mavens of Jewish music including Craig Taubman, Dan Nichols, Danny Maseng, and more. He is the author of seventeen books of poems including "I'm a Jew Are You" and "Feeding Holy Cats". He is also the editor of three poetry anthologies including "A Poet's Haggadah - Passover Through the Eyes of Poets." Involved in the Los Angeles poetry community since 1990, he served for two years as co-director of the Valley Contemporary Poets and is the founder of Poetry Super Highway, one of the internet's most extensive poetry resources. His poetry has appeared in numerous magazines and literary journals, including The CCAR Journal, The Los Angeles Jewish Journal, The Blue Jew Yorker, The Los Angeles Times, Rattle, Chiron Review, Red Fez, Zuzu's Petals, The Bicycle Review, Caffeine Magazine, and Blue Satellite.

Rick performs his poetry at a range of cultural and academic venues throughout the United States and abroad.
